Housing (VERY IMPORTANT)	Finding accommodation is a very difficult issue here in Innsbruck. The students must apply as soon as possible to get a room in a student home (Studentenheim). Winter term: application recommended <u>in March</u> Summer term: application recommended <u>in September</u> <b>Students must send the reservation deposit immediately, otherwise</b> <b>the application will not be handled.</b> The rooms are given on a first come, first served basis.
