Room and Board	On-Campus Housing	There are student dorms available to international students. Please note that there are strict deadlines for reserving a room. A room costs between 228 and 340 EUR per month depending on the size. (subject to change) If they rent a room in the dorm, they must be rented for <b>five full</b> months. (Apr – Aug, Oct –Feb). The last rent will not be deducted from the deposit of <b>€500</b> but must be paid in full. The deposit will be refunded separately.

There is a cafeteria as well as a dining hall available on campus. In the dining hall, you can calculate around 3-4 EUR per meal. Finances	Opening a bank account: Bring along some money to deposit in your new account as well as your tax number from your home country. If you have already opened a blocked account prior to your arrival, then the German bank already has this number.  Please note that some students must open a blocked account prior to their arrival (see proof of sufficient funds). These students will receive the necessary information in advance. Please bring all necessary papers.
