| Room and Board | On-Campus Housing | The PHW has student dorms available to international students. Please note that there are strict deadlines for reserving a room. A room costs between 228 and 329 EUR per month depending on the size. (subject to change) If you rent a room in the dorm, they must be rented for five full months. (Apr – Aug, Oct –Feb). The last rent will not be deducted from your deposit of €500 but must be paid in full. The deposit will be refunded separately. |

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| | Off-campus housing | The following newspapers might be helpful for your house hunting in and around Weingarten: Schwäbische Zeitung, Wochenblatt or INFO (Der Südfinder). | Arrival | Train station pickup | The International Office at the PH Weingarten offers a pick-up service on the official Arrival Day from Hauptbahnhof Ravensburg (Ravensburg main train station). We will provide more information before arrival. |

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| <p>Finances</p> | <p><u>Opening a bank account:</u> Bring along some money to deposit in your new account as well as your tax number from your home country. If you have already opened a blocked account prior to your arrival, then the German bank already has this number.</p> <p>Please note that some students must open a blocked account prior to their arrival (see proof of sufficient funds). These students will receive the necessary information in advance. Please bring all necessary papers.</p> <p><u>Proof of sufficient financial means:</u> Germany has specific requirements for each country concerning proof of sufficient funds. Therefore, please contact the International Office about the necessary documentation needed before you arrive.</p> |
